English Language Arts

Renaissance Unit Independent Project — Students learned about significant people from the Renaissance. Students applied and expanded their understanding by highlighting their most impactful person with additional research and creative digital production.

Math

They engaged in various activities to review previously taught concepts and strengthen their understanding of concepts taught in class.
